## Alto Adige Riesling DOC - 2024 Alto Adige, Italy

<b>Type:</b>	White Still Wine
<b>Ingredients:</b>	Riesling
<b>Region:</b>	Alto Adige, Sud Tirol Kaltern/Caldaro Alto Adige DOC
<b>Vineyard:</b>	The vineyards are situated at high altitudes, ranging from 500 to 600 meters above sea level, and are characterized by calcareous soils covering 5.4 hectares.
<b>Vineyard Size:</b>	5.4 ha
<b>Planted:</b>	2010
<b>Farming Methods:</b>	Manual labor; Guyot training system.
<b>Total Production:</b>	1,200 cases per year
<b>Soil:</b>	Calcareous soils
<b>Climate:</b>	This region features a unique blend of alpine and Mediterranean climates. Summers are typically hot, with temperatures exceeding 30°C, while nights remain cool, often dropping below 20°C. With approximately 300 days of sunshine per year, the area enjoys abundant warmth. Winters, however, are cold and may bring snowfall.
<b>Fermentation:</b>	Fermentation occurs in stainless steel tanks.
<b>Winemaker:</b>	Thomas Scarizuola
<b>Elevage:</b>	Aged for four months on fine lees in stainless steel tanks.

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### ABOUT THIS BOTTLE

Versatile in pairing, it complements fish, crustaceans, and seafood, as well as white meats and Asian cuisine. Best served chilled, it is perfect for warm summer evenings or as an aperitif. The wine has a light golden-yellow color with subtle greenish reflections. On the nose, it is fresh and slightly aromatic, with fruity notes of white peach and apricot, complemented by delicate hints of rose and citrus. On the palate, it is dry, fresh, and medium-bodied, with a juicy, mineral character. The finish is long and lingering. Reduction of carbon emissions, enhanced biodiversity, and social commitment.
